PRIVACY NOTICE FOR PHOTOS OF PERSONS PHOTOGRAPHED AT PHOTO SECTION OF OLAF'S OPEN DAY STAND

1. DESCRIPTION OF THE PROCESSING OPERATION

OLAF has a stand at the EU Open Day which presents OLAF's work to the public. The stand has a photo booth at which members of the public may choose to have their picture taken and printed instantly on paper. The data (pictures of the person) are only collected electronically for the seconds it takes to process the photo for printing and are deleted automatically immediately after. No copy of the pictures or any other personal data is kept by OLAF or the processor.

The aim of the processing is to bring OLAF closer to citizens and to publicise our work further with them.

2. LEGAL BASIS FOR THE PROCESSING

The legal basis for this processing is Article 5 paragraph 1(d) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725.

3. CATEGORIES OF PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

The photographs are taken by the data subject himself/herself and immediately printed on paper for the data subject to keep and the electronic copy deleted.

4. WHO HAS ACCESS TO YOUR INFORMATION AND TO WHOM IS IT DISCLOSED?

The only recipients of the photos will be the data subjects themselves (only in printed version).

5. HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR DATA?

No data are kept by OLAF or by the contractor working under the instructions of OLAF.

6. WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS AND HOW YOU CAN EXERCISE THEM?

The personal data (pictures) are erased automatically after the instant printing. Subsequently, it will not be possible to grant access, rectify or erase such data.

In accordance with the Regulation 2018/1725 any request to exercise your rights under Regulation 2018/1725 should be directed to the Controller (<u>OLAF-FMB-DATA-PROTECTION@ec.europa.eu</u>).
