Customs duties represent around 12.5% of the total amount of duties and taxes on cigarettes in the EU.

1.000 master cases of cigarettes (a full 40 foot container) represents an average of **1.500.000** € in duties and taxes, but it is obviously higher in, for example, the UK and lower in, for example, Spain and Portugal.

The total amount of cigarettes seized in 2003 (excluding the United Kingdom) is 161.232 master cases.

Total amount of Customs duties on these cigarettes is around € 30.000.000
