PRIVACY NOTICE FOR THE OLAF CORRESPONDENTS AND FRAUD PREVENTION AND DETECTION NETWORK (FPDNet) MEMBERS

1. DESCRIPTION OF THE PROCESSING OPERATION

This processing operation consists of maintaining a list with the name, function, DG/Unit of the OLAF Correspondents and FPDNet members.

The list will be used by OLAF staff for the following purposes:

- a) to contact OLAF correspondents and FPDNet members for investigations and fraud prevention matters and organise meetings;
- b) to provide contact information about the OLAF correspondents and FPDNet members on the intranet (the FPDNet page).

The processing of your data will not be used for an automated decision-making, including profiling.

2. LEGAL BASIS FOR THE PROCESSING

The legal basis for this processing is Article 5 paragraph 1 (a) and (b) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725.

Processing is necessary for the performance of OLAF's tasks foreseen by the Regulation 883/2013 consolidated, the 2019 Commission Antifraud Strategy (COM(2019)196) and its Action Plan (SWD(2019)170) and the 2011 Commission Antifraud Strategy (COM(2011) 376 final).

Some members of the FPDNet joined the network on their initiative. Their data are processed on the basis of Article 5 paragraph 1 (d) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725.

3. CATEGORIES OF PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

In order to carry out this processing operation OLAF collects the following categories of personal data: name, function, DG/unit.

For the OLAF correspondents, the source from which your personal data originate is the DG/service.

For the FPDNet members, the personal data are collected from the data subject (the provision of the personal data is not mandatory, but is voluntarily provided by FPDNet members) and the DG/service.

4. WHO HAS ACCESS TO YOUR INFORMATION AND TO WHOM IS IT DISCLOSED?

OLAF staff responsible for carrying out this processing operation has access to your personal data.

The information on the intranet page is available to all Commission services.

5. HOW DO WE PROTECT AND SAFEGUARD YOUR INFORMATION?

In order to protect your personal data, a number of technical and organisational measures have been put in place. Technical measures include appropriate actions to address online security, risk of data loss, alteration of data or unauthorised access, taking into consideration the risk presented by the processing and the nature of the data being processed. Organisational measures include restricting access to the data to authorised persons with a legitimate need to know for the purposes of this processing operation.

6. HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR DATA?

For the OLAF Correspondents, your personal data may be retained by OLAF until the service who nominated you requests to have your name removed from list.

For the FPDNet members, your personal data may be retained by OLAF until you or your DG/service request to have your name removed from the network.

7. WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS AND HOW YOU CAN EXERCISE THEM?

You have the right to request access to your personal data, rectification or erasure of the data, or restriction of their processing.

You have the right to object to the processing of your data.

Any request to exercise one of those rights should be directed to the Controller (<u>OLAF-FMB-DATA-PROTECTION@ec.europa.eu</u>). Where you wish to exercise your rights in the context of one or several specific processing operations or files, please provide their description and reference(s) in your request.

Exceptions based on Regulation 2018/1725 may apply.

8. CONTACT DETAILS OF THE DATA PROTECTION OFFICER

9. RIGHT OF RECOURSE

You have the right to have recourse to the European Data Protection Supervisor (edps@edps.europa.eu) if you consider that your rights under Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 have been infringed as a result of the processing of your personal data by OLAF.
