4TH MEETING OAFCN, BRUSSELS, **25-26** NOVEMBER **2003** - CONCLUSIONS

- 1. The Network should continue to grow and expand as well as to invite new membership from national investigative services in the Member States and candidate countries not currently represented
- 2. The members will furnish the Network with a case study which involves co-operation between the national service and OLAF, these can be furnished in the members' native language. It can be any length but it should be such a length that it can be published without legal problems, and it should be comprehensible to the general public. As soon as OLAF has a number of these, they will be put on the OLAF website.
- 3. The Bucharest seminar conclusions will be published as will the results of the Salamanca training event.
- 4. Several members have expressed their willingness come to Brussels in 2004 to present the Network to the COCOLAF group of Member State experts
- 5. The results of the Eurobarometer opinion poll will be published only after a draft press release has been distributed to the members in advance of publication by the European Commission and OLAF so as to maximise the media impact.
- 6. The Network will try to organise ad-hoc training events for journalists especially in the candidate countries.
- 7. OLAF will try to organise a number of training events for communicators or for journalists in line with what had been achieved in previous years but depending on funding
- **8.** All members are encouraged to lobby their representative in the Council of Ministers in relation to the development and reinforcement of the notion of communication and information as a means of prevention of fraud against the EU budget.
