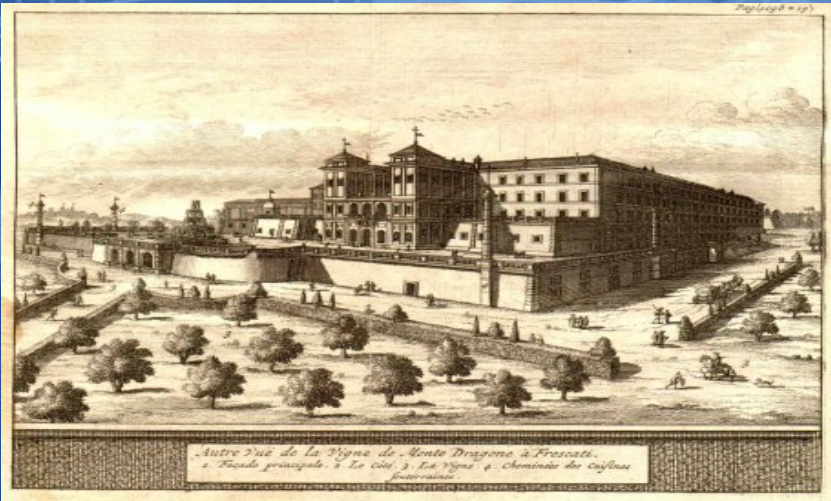

Central coordination to provide support in getting European funding within the Programmes of the European Union

1) Information, training, proposal phase

- funding opportunities
- info days; training events, capacity building
- technical support (budget, GANTT e PERT application forms,)

2) Management

- Negotiation with EC
- *Consortium Agreement*
- coordination of the project management in terms of cost eligibility, financial rules (compliance of European rules, national legislation and internal rules;

3) Reporting

- Accounting fiscal support (ex. IRAP, VAT)
- Support during Audit actions:
 - i. Internal Auditing (monitoring the costs, eligibility)
 - ii. External Auditing (mandatory by selected Auditors);
