

PRIVACY NOTICE FOR GETI4ALL

1. DESCRIPTION OF THE PROCESSING OPERATION

The getI4all system is designed to assist dedicated OLAF staff when performing initial assessment of incoming information of possible investigative interest or analysis of cases. getI4all provides a search platform allowing to make searches in a subset of the EU data bases such as Tender electronic daily, CORDIS and publicly available information (e.g. press articles). geti4all contains essentially data about companies and EU funded projects, but may include, in some cases, limited information on individuals. The purpose of using this tool is to enrich the initial information with already available data sets from several sources in one go. The data is stored and searchable in geti4all as long as it is available in the original sources. When a new data is added, this may trigger manual verification of the relevance of the entry.

The processing of the data is not used for automated decision making, including profiling.

2. LEGAL BASIS FOR THE PROCESSING

The legal basis for this processing operation is Regulation 883/2013, in accordance with Article 5 paragraph 1 point (a) of Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 and the European Commission Anti-Fraud Strategy COM(2019) 196 final/29.4.2019.

3. CATEGORIES OF PERSONAL DATA COLLECTED

In order to carry out this processing operation OLAF processes the following categories of personal data related to individuals: name of the OLAF staff requesting access, requested accesses in getI4all start date/end date for the access rights.

4. WHO HAS ACCESS TO YOUR INFORMATION AND TO WHOM IS IT DISCLOSED?

Only competent OLAF staff

5. HOW DO WE PROTECT AND SAFEGUARD YOUR INFORMATION?

In order to protect your personal data, a number of technical and organisational measures have been put in place. Technical measures include appropriate actions to address online security, risk of data loss, alteration of data or unauthorised access, taking into consideration the nature of the data.

6. HOW LONG DO WE KEEP YOUR DATA?

Your personal data may be retained by OLAF for a maximum of 10 years after the removal of the access to getI4all.

7. WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS AND HOW YOU CAN EXERCISE THEM?

You have the right to request access to your personal data, rectification or erasure of the data, or restriction of their processing.

You have the right to object to the processing of your data.

Any request to exercise one of those rights should be directed to the Controller (OLAF-FMB-DATA-PROTECTION@ec.europa.eu). Where you wish to exercise your rights in the context of one or several specific processing operations or files, please provide their description and reference(s) in your request.

The controller may apply exceptions in accordance with the Regulation 2018/1725 and restrictions based on Article 25 thereof in accordance with the Commission Decision 2018/1962
