

Short biography of Joanna Krzeminska-Vamvaka

Joanna Krzeminska-Vamvaka is Director in Directorate A, Operations and Investigations (Expenditure) in the European Anti-Fraud Office, OLAF. She was a Head of Unit of the Single Entry Point for Enforcement, Market Access and SMEs as well as Head of Unit in the Trade Defence Directorate, both in the Directorate-General for External Trade of the European Commission. She started her career in the European Commission in 2005, in the Directorate for Renewable Energies in the Directorate-General for Transport and Energy.

Prior to joining the European Commission, she was a doctoral researcher in the Centre for European Law and Politics at the University of Bremen in Germany for a project “Fundamental Rights and Private Law in the European Union”.

Joanna holds a Doctor Juris degree from the University of Bremen in Germany (2008), a Master in European and International Law from University of Bremen (2002) and a Master of Law from Wroclaw University in Poland (2001). She was an Erasmus student at the University of Salzburg in Austria.
